The HorsePower Experiential Learning Program (HELP) was founded in 2001. It is the longest running behavioral health equine program in the

Greater Kansas City area. We provide a unique equine facilitated, hands-on, learning program for at-risk youth ages 6 - 18 who have challenges due to circumstances that have caused emotional or behavioral challenges. HorsePower's goal is to enable our students to experience, practice, and re-learn various "life-coping skills" through equine facilitated experiential learning.

OUR CHALLENGE Since 2001, HELP has been fortunate to be able to board and lease at five different locations. Although the facilities allowed us to refine and grow the program, not owning the

property where we serve our students creates numerous challenges. Without a place to call home, the HorsePower program has limitations beyond our control.

THE REALITY

A hard number to face. Nearly half of American children—are exposed to adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) that can severely harm their future health and well-being.

50% of all lifetime mental health conditions begin before the age of 14.

Trauma experiences can leave a person feeling isolated, hurt, confused, and unsure AND can be especially pronounced in our most vulnerable populations – children.

The tumultuous feelings lead to dysregulation and further emotional isolation.

Enter the horse, a majestic, sentient being with no ulterior motives. Children can feel safe building connections and relationships with horses because they were not the source of their trauma - humans were. Studies show that developing the horse-human relationship can actually rebuild neural pathways in the upper regions of the brain. Practicing and relearning respect, trust, and empathy create a healthy and mutually beneficial relationship that children may never have experienced before.

At HorsePower, students re-learn social and life skills, experience healing attachments and have regulating experiences...all through equine facilitated activities.

I have not seen Jack* excited about anything for a really long time and now all he talks about is horses and wanting to work with them. Even as a Veterinarian! OUR VISION


HorsePower is seeking a private and welcoming ranch setting which can provide an expanded opportunity to serve students with our unique program.
